OPEN LETTER

Dear Sir Christopher

Re: The Rule of Law and the Power to Create Money – See <http://edm1297.info>

Further to our previous correspondence, this is to draw to your attention the plight of HM subjects of which, I am sure, you are perfectly unaware. Just as in fairy tales, ministers tell Their Majesties that all's well, when the reality is quite different. To illustrate the real state of affairs, I enclose a copy of our petition with some of the comments of the first 331 signatories. It will, of course, continue to be read and signed on the web. It appears that not even you could do anything to redress the situation as long as the *Bank of England* continues to issue credit as national or public debt, thus taking the power to create interest-free money away from Your Majesty's Government. See <http://publicdebts.org.uk>. The resulting artificial scarcity of money has fostered a climate of greed and corruption that can only be redressed by changing the basis of issue, the instruments of money supply and the mechanisms of its control.

The first national debt was created through the *Bank of England Act 1694* and the Royal Charter on June 27th, 1694. This Act was expressly written with the intention of Their Majesties' subjects not being oppressed by the corporation and therefore even foresaw a punishment in case of such wrongdoing. The present crisis has made it more obvious than ever that a serious state of oppression has been reigning. Our Chairman Austin Mitchell MP has addressed this state of affairs in *Early Day Motions* since 2002, and especially with *EDM 1297* of April 20, 2009, entitled *Enforcement of Bank of England Act 1694*.

However, Your Majesty's subjects continue to suffer and there is ample evidence that no institution is sufficiently ethically responsible to redress the current state of institutional injustice and cruelty. Besides the monetary reason for artificial scarcity, we have had to conclude that the principle of self-regulation does not work, either for the financial or the legal profession and that Royal Charters are being abused.

As expressed in our petition, Your Majesty's subjects therefore have no other choice than to rely on the historic tradition of *Grand Juries* to investigate the evidence of instances and effects of self-regulation with respect to the cause, the abuse of the money supply by the *Bank of England*, and to the effects of corruption and fraud in the legal profession and the judiciary system.

Trusting that we can count on your wisdom of reign, I remain Her Majesty's humble servant.
