Re: Money – the economic weapon in financial wars

This letter comes to you in connection with the one by *Paul Talbot-Jenkins* regarding the devastating effect of the financial industry on the real economy. I met Paul through my efforts on behalf of victims of financial exploitation and legal oppression. See <http://edm1297.info>. But the real reason why I am applying my skills to their cause is because, so far, I have failed to raise funds for my innovative software inventions. The reasons are exactly the ones that Paul describes. As a mathematician and former software diagnostician at CERN in Geneva, I publish them on <http://3d-metrics.com>. Some of my attempts are documented on my *3D Metrics* blog: <http://3dmetrics.me.uk/>.

You may remember that, when we met for the first time at a dinner of the *Economic Research Council*, you said that maybe you should find out what money is... The most comprehensive book is *The Lost Science of Money*, by Stephen Zarlenga, a former trader who's devoted his life to the *American Monetary Institute*, (AMI), pursuing the same kind of goals as the *Forum for Stable Currencies*. However, the AMI does not work on behalf of victims who have been joining our *Forum* meetings, ever since we started in 1998. Many of them feel that they are being mistreated, because of fear of massive compensation payouts.

This is where the arguments of *monetary reform* and those of seriously oppressed victims meet: the Treasury should remember that it can print its own money and does NOT have to borrow via the Bank of England or raise taxes. This was the subject of our submission to the *Treasury Select Committee* in 2007: *Green Credit for Green Purposes*. See <http://greencredit.files.wordpress.com/2007/01/green-credit.pdf>. While some victims feel that their particular perpetrators should be called to pay for compensation, the State could use this opportunity to 'bail out' the judiciary just as it 'helped' banks. But, by appealing to the right mindsets in the right Ministers, I am sure you could go much further. Meanwhile I hope that the Victims Commissioner Louise Casey will use us as a *Watchdog for White Collar Crime*.



- Furthermore, there is the opinion that the UK State is operating against EU articles of human rights. Two of the victims who have achieved victory on EU level continue to be harassed particularly badly:

 - and Raymond Fox, a formerly successful business man who bought a house near an alleged nuclear bunker of Shell. He has not only been bankrupted, but also evicted to become homeless: see <http://www.rayfox.info/>, one of the four cases we put before you in our letter that Shona Manson responded to.

There are of course many, many other groups with different focus and emphasis on similar issues, and we will be able to offer better quantitative assessments in due course.

Meanwhile, I'd like you to consider that money which was invented as a *medium of exchange*, has become a *tool for control* by those who have the privilege to create it from thin air. See the Guardian publication <http://bit.ly/bnB2Q4> And thus our pincer movement oscillates between money as the *cause* of institutionalised greed and corruption and victims as the *effect* of while collar crime.

Given your Government's intention to take white collar crime seriously, we trust that you will continue to be interested in our findings, and that you will aid us in dealing with our issues thoroughly and effectively.
